

TERMS AND CONDITIONS: 2026 State of Origin Promotion

Your participation in the Silks Darwin 2026 State of Origin promotion ('the Competition') constitutes deemed acceptance of the following terms and conditions:

1. **This is a Members-only draw**
2. By entering, you acknowledge that each eligible entry has an equal chance of winning the relevant prize and winners will be drawn by Silks Darwin.
3. The Promoter of the Competition is Silks Darwin. Silks Darwin reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and to disqualify any entrant who tampers with the entry process or who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these terms and conditions. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
4. To be eligible to enter the Competition, entrants must be current financial members of Silks Darwin and be 18 years of age or older.
5. The Competition is a members-only promotion. Non-members may join at Silks Darwin reception during the promotional period in order to become eligible to enter.
6. The Competition will be conducted across the three 2026 State of Origin matches shown at Silks Darwin on the following dates:
 - a) Game 1 - Wednesday, 27 May 2026;
 - b) Game 2 - Wednesday, 17 June 2026; and
 - c) Game 3 - Wednesday, 8 July 2026.
7. To enter each game-night draw, eligible members must obtain an entry ticket through the Wymac kiosk during the promotional period for that game and select either New South Wales or Queensland as their chosen state for that night's match.
8. Each eligible entry will be placed into the barrel corresponding with the state selected by the entrant for that game.
9. Only entries correctly completed through the Wymac kiosk for the relevant game-night draw will be accepted. Silks Darwin accepts no responsibility for incomplete, incorrect, lost, late or misdirected entries.
10. The promotional period for each game commences when entries open at Silks Darwin on the relevant game day and closes at the start of each match.
11. At half time of each game, minor prize draws will be conducted from both state barrels as follows:
 - a) Game 1 - two (2) draws from the New South Wales barrel and two (2) draws from the Queensland barrel for four (4) prizes of \$50 Silks gift vouchers;
 - b) Game 2 - two (2) draws from the New South Wales barrel and two (2) draws from the Queensland barrel for four (4) prizes of \$50 Silks gift vouchers; and
 - c) Game 3 - two (2) draws from the New South Wales barrel and two (2) draws from the Queensland barrel for four (4) prizes of \$50 Silks gift vouchers, plus one (1) additional \$50 Silks gift voucher draw, for a total of five (5) prizes of \$50 Silks gift vouchers.
12. At full time of each game, one (1) entry will be drawn from the barrel representing the winning state for that match. The drawn entry will win one (1) cash prize of \$250.
13. Entries that selected the winning state in Game 1 and Game 2 will remain eligible for the major draw after Game 3. Following the full-time cash draw for Game 3, all entries from the winning state barrels across Game 1, Game 2 and Game 3 will be placed into one main barrel for the major prize draws.
14. The major prize draws will be conducted after the full-time Game 3 draw on Wednesday, 8 July 2026. The prizes are:
 - a) one (1) major cash prize of \$1,000; and
 - b) three (3) minor cash prizes of \$200 each.
15. The total prize pool for the Competition is valued at \$3,000, comprising:
 - a. \$2,350 in cash prizes and
 - b. \$650 in Silks gift vouchers.
16. All winners must be present at Silks Darwin at the time of the draw in order to claim their prize.
17. Winners will have one (1) minute from the time their name or entry is announced to present themselves to claim the prize. If a winner does not claim within that timeframe, a redraw will occur until the prize is claimed.
18. Entrants may win more than once during the Competition.
19. Silks gift vouchers are not redeemable for cash and must be used in accordance with any conditions printed on the voucher or otherwise advised by Silks Darwin.

20. Cash prizes will be paid in the manner determined by Silks Darwin. Winners of prizes are not eligible to receive receipts for their winnings.
21. There is no replacement for lost, stolen or damaged prizes, vouchers or winnings once awarded.
22. Any staff member employed by the Darwin Turf Club or Silks Darwin is eligible to enter but cannot claim a prize while on duty or in uniform.
23. Silks Darwin reserves the right to disqualify any entrant reasonably suspected of forgery, tampering, misconduct or acting in a manner contrary to the spirit of the Competition.

If this Competition is interfered with in any way, or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion and to the fullest extent permitted by law, subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority, to disqualify any entrant or to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the Competition, as appropriate.
25. The name of a winner may be published and winners may be asked to participate in publicity regarding the Competition, including social media content, photography, video and local media coverage.

Silks Darwin accepts no responsibility or liability for any delay or failure to deliver a prize, or for any failure to meet any of its obligations in these terms and conditions where such delay or failure is due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control. Silks Darwin will use its best endeavours to facilitate prize delivery or collection as soon as practicable where relevant.
27. Prizes cannot be transferred, returned or exchanged except at the sole discretion of Silks Darwin.

To the extent permitted by law, Silks Darwin (including its officers, employees and agents) excludes all liability (including negligence) for any personal injury or any loss or damage, whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the Competition, including but not limited to: (a) any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction; (b) any theft, unauthorised access or third-party interference; (c) any entry, prize or claim for a prize that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of Silks Darwin; or (d) any variation in prize value to that stated in these terms and conditions.
